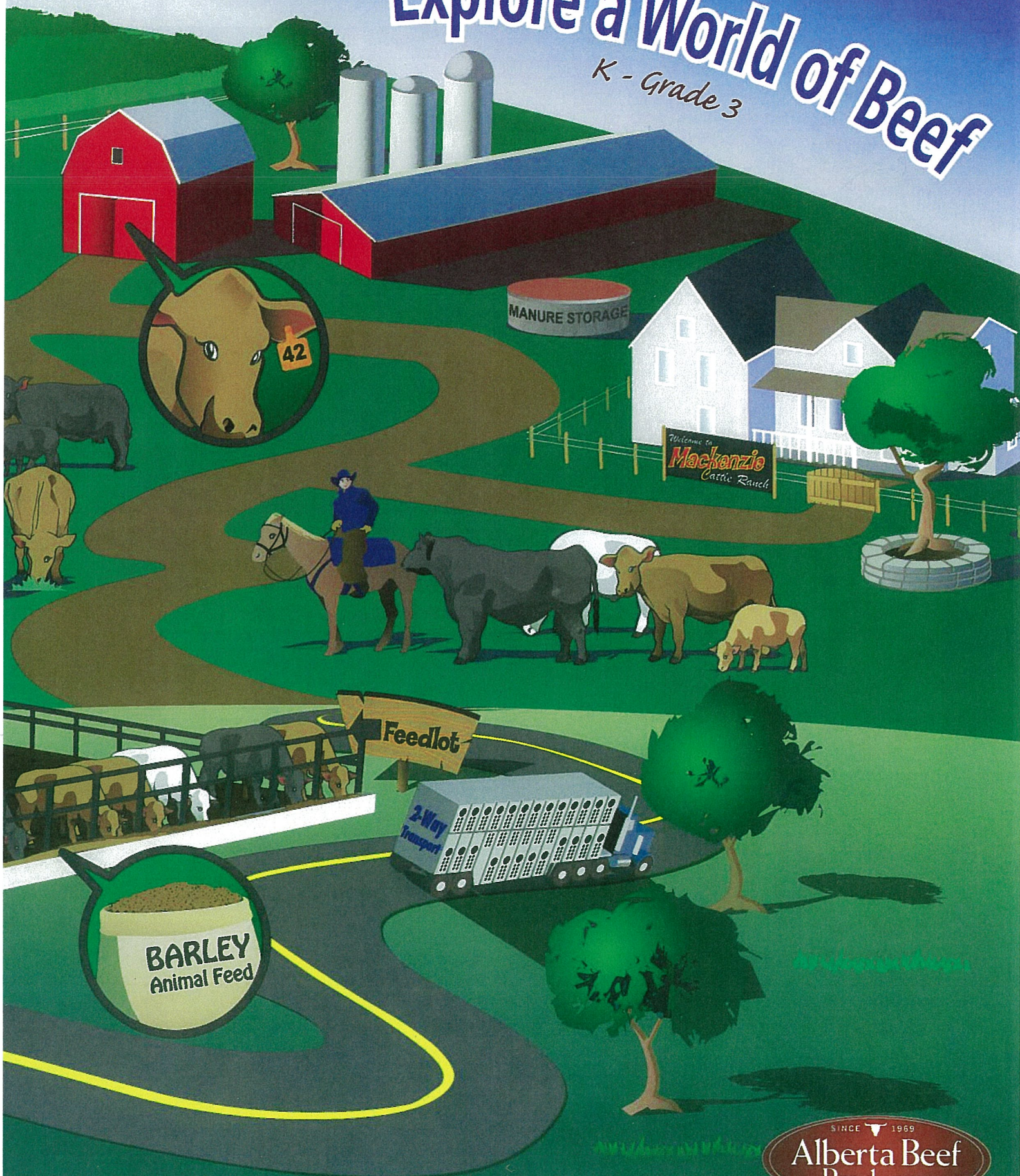

### FAST FACT

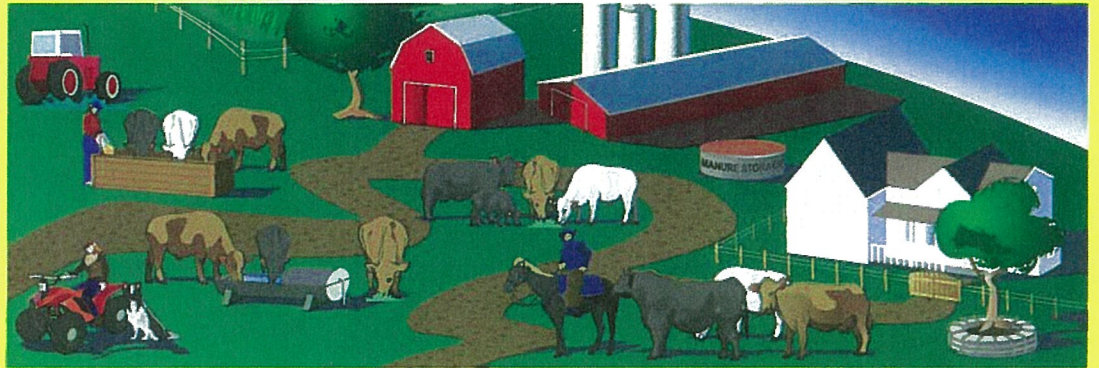
Cattle eat grass by wrapping their tongues around the grass and pulling it into their mouths.
